The West Yorkshire Archive Service holds over 54m³ of police records, which equates to over 2700 boxes of material. Within the various police collections there is a vast variety of information mainly about the police officers themselves and how the forces functioned on a day to day basis, but also some information on criminals and crime.

Due to the sensitive nature of the majority of the police records we hold many of the records under 100 years old may be subject to legal restrictions so we strongly suggest you contact our Wakefield office for further details on any records you may wish to view.

Most of the Borough forces and the West Riding Constabulary collections have been fully listed and the catalogues are available to view on our <u>online catalogue</u>. Work is continuing on the later West Yorkshire Forces records to make them available on our online catalogue at a future time.

This guide is designed to be a general introduction to the range of records we hold relating to the police, it is by no means a comprehensive guide and if there are any records relating to the police in West Yorkshire that are not mentioned please do contact our Wakefield office where staff will be able to advise you further.

The police records held in the collections referred to in this guide tend to be records about the forces, how they were set up and operated and of the police who worked for them rather than records about criminals [although there are some criminal records within the collection]. If you are interested in criminal records then court records, petty sessions and quarter sessions records [all held by WYAS] may be of more use to your research. Please use our online catalogue or contact the relevant office to get more information on these types of record.
